SAINT ROCH VIEILLES VIGNES BLANC COTES DU ROUSSILLON GRENACHE BLANC ROUSSANNE 2019

'From the Côtes du Roussillon, Midi wine region, Saint-Roch 2019 is a great value, dry, full-bodied, old vines white wine blend of mostly Grenache Blanc with some Roussanne added to the mix. Fragrant on the nose with lemon and orange blossom, ripe pear and tropical fruit. Rich on the palate with ripe pear, melon, pineapple finishing on a mineral note and balanced with food-friendly acidity. Chill and enjoy with fresh steamed lobster with a light garlic butter sauce. Food pairings: roast turkey with all the trimmings,

tender roast pork.'
